TRIP ITINERARY

This is a sample itinerary that could be modified during your trip, based on weather, wellness of the group, availability of local project partners, and other important factors. We appreciate your understanding and adaptability with the itinerary.

DAY 1: ARRIVAL IN ZANZIBAR

Arrive on the island of Zanzibar and meet your GIVE guides at the airport. Transfer to your accommodations in historic Stone Town, settle in, go for a quick swim and enjoy a group welcome dinner together. Take in the island breeze and prepare for the days of culture, community, and adventure ahead.





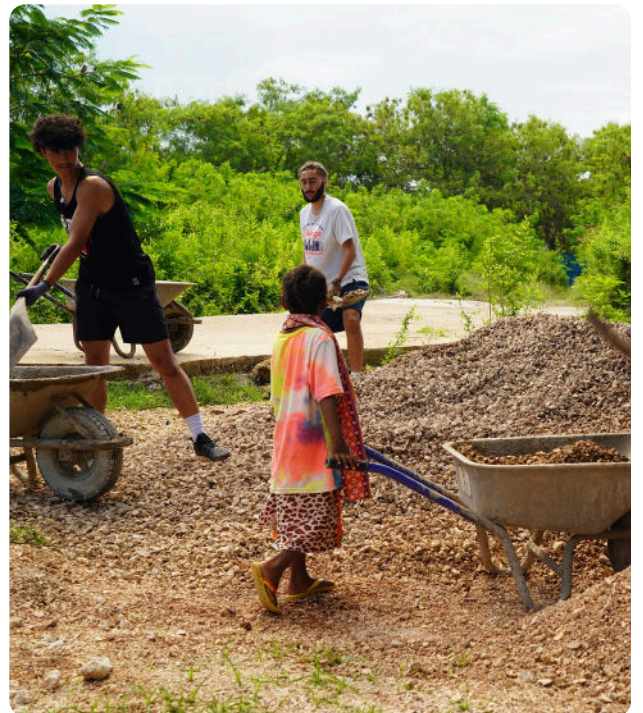
DAY 2: STONE TOWN HISTORY & ARRIVAL IN KAIRO VILLAGE

Begin your journey with a guided walking tour of Stone Town's UNESCO World Heritage sites including the former Slave Market Museum where you'll learn about Zanzibar's deep and dynamic history. After lunch, travel across the island to Kairo Village, GIVE's long-term partner community. Settle into your new coastal home, meet the local team and enjoy dinner on the beach as you prepare for the upcoming volunteer days.

DAY 3-4: VOLUNTEER PROJECTS & CULTURAL CONNECTION

Spend your days volunteering at Skuli ya Kairo GIVE, a school co-created with the local community. Rotate between construction projects like mixing cement, painting, gardening and building classrooms and also education projects where you'll be working alongside the local team to help tutor local students in English.

During the first few volunteers days, join Swahili lessons after lunch and take part in a village walking tour to explore Kairo's markets, homes, and history while experiencing daily life in the village.





DAY 5: ISLAND ADVENTURE DAY

Set sail aboard a traditional wooden dhow for a full day exploring Zanzibar's turquoise lagoons and coral reefs. Snorkel in vibrant marine sanctuaries, relax on a remote sandbank, and share a freshly-grilled seafood lunch with your group. Expect dolphins, beautiful reefs, tons of fish, volleyball on the beach and lots of laughter, a thank you for all your hard work in the community.

DAY 6-8: VOLUNTEERING & CULTURAL IMMERSION

Continue your volunteer projects at Skuli ya Kairo GIVE, alternating between construction and classroom activities as you help strengthen the school campus and support the local students.

Between work sessions on these days you will get to take part in a cooking class with the local women, a soap-making demonstration, and unwind one evening on a sunset dhow cruise along the northern coast.





DAY 9: SPICE FARM TOUR & TRAVEL TO DAR ES SALAAM

Say farewell to Kairo and drive across the island to a working spice farm, where you'll learn all about the spices that gave the "Spice Islands" their name. Enjoy a flavorful farm-to-table lunch before heading to the airport to catch your short flight to Dar es Salaam. Spend the night in Dar and rest up for the next leg of your adventure...Safari!

DAY 10: JOURNEY TO NYERERE NATIONAL PARK & BOAT SAFARI

Travel south to Nyerere National Park, one of Africa's largest protected wilderness areas. Upon arrival, settle into camp, enjoy lunch, take a refreshing swim, and then head out on a sunset boat safari along the Rufiji River, spotting hippos, crocodiles, and hundreds of bird species as the sun sets over the mountains.





DAY 11: FULL-DAY SAFARI GAME DRIVE

Spend a full day on a game drive through Nyerere National Park in open-air vehicles. Look for lions, giraffes, elephants, zebras, wildebeest, buffalo, and countless bird species across savanna, woodland, and wetland landscapes. Enjoy a picnic lunch in the bush before returning to camp for an educational discussion about conservation in the park and a tasty dinner!

DAY 12: RETURN TO DAR ES SALAAM & DEPARTURE

Enjoy your final breakfast along the banks of the Rufiji River before beginning the drive back to Dar es Salaam. Reflect on all you've experienced, from coral reefs to classrooms and safaris, before catching your evening flight home. For those with late flights, enjoy the evening exploring the northern region of Dar es Salaam with your team of guides.



WHERE YOU'LL BE STAYING

Night 1: In Stone Town, you'll stay in a charming guesthouse within walking distance of the city's historic landmarks, seaside promenade, and colorful markets.



Nights 2-8: For the week on the coast, we'll settle into a beachfront lodge overlooking the Indian Ocean. Shared rooms include private bathrooms and a breezy upstairs lounge area for relaxing and connecting with friends.



Nights 9-11: Night 9 will be spent in Dar es Salaam before heading south to Nyerere NP. Enjoy comfortable safari tents, stunning nature, and a pool to unwind after your days on safari.
