Key Responsibilities & Expectations:

- Maintain an extremely high-level of on-foot, in-person engagement and a sense of urgency to generate and convert new volunteers

- Maintain in-depth knowledge and understanding of GIVE's programs
- Strategize and implement creative new ways to raise awareness of GIVE on campus
